Jason is a Florida native, growing up in the small town of Palatka in northeast Florida.

Jason fell in love with weather at a very young age. When he was in middle school, Jason used his mom's video camera to tape his own weather segments, featuring hand drawn maps and screenshots from the Weather Channel. After rounding up a few other neighborhood kids to record news and sports, he would deliver copies of the "Neighborhood News" to every house on

the block.

Jason's passion for broadcasting and meteorology led him to the University of Florida where he earned a Bachelor's degree in Telecommunication. Jason then studied meteorology at Mississippi State University and received his Master's Degree in 2009.

Jason has covered major weather events throughout his career, ranging from tornado outbreaks in Mississippi to major hurricane landfalls like Irma and most recently hurricane Ian."

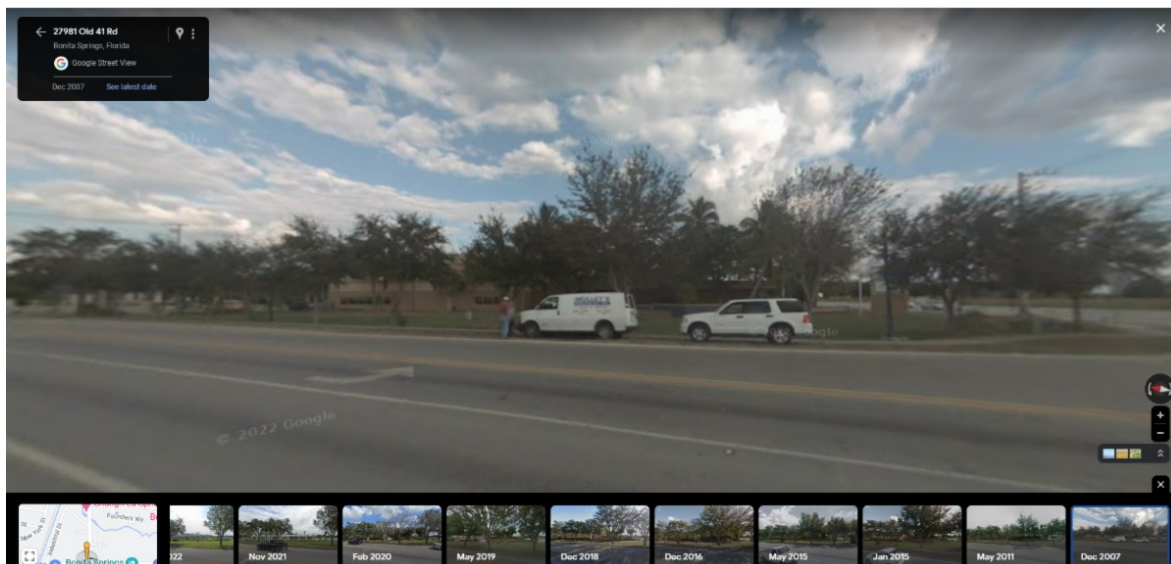
