- Don't use fire.
- Don't use tents larger than 10x10
- Don't give out marketing materials. It's meant to be fun for the kids, this is not a trade show.

The City of Bonita Springs will be hosting it's "Halloween in the Park: In Riverside Park" event for the second time. This year, as a part of the 25th anniversary, the City is adding a Halloween Stroll through the Liles Hotel area of Riverside Park.




